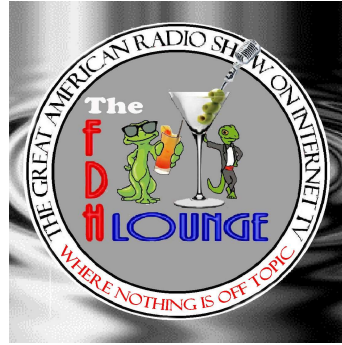

Zeev Buium Talks About How Winning Fuels Him

The World Junior Championship is a very important tournament for players. Besides representing your country, young players who perform well seem to get a leg up for the rest of the season. Zeev Buium felt that and then some.

"It adds a different level of confidence. With the World Juniors, everybody dreams about it when they're a kid. To be on that team and to win was crazy," Buium explained. "It gives you more confidence going into the second half of the year. To be able to be on that team and win.

"When you get that winning feeling. When you win once you want to win again. A big thing was trying to put that away for the remainder of the year and focus on that goal was an actual championship (with Denver). David Carle and all the guys helped me with that. Coming back to Denver. Settling in and winning a National Championship. Like I was the entire year. I think that adds another layer of confidence."

Playing elimination games is a great experience and Buium already has a lot of experience in them. "You get that first taste of it at the World Juniors. It's even scarier because it's a new group of guys. New systems and you have to get to know each other quickly. The turnaround is different. At Denver, it made me realize that the National Championship was in reach. We knew we could do it knowing how tight we were and how good the culture was. For me personally, after the World Juniors, I didn't think we could lose."

Buium's game changed in the second half of the season. He clearly got physically stronger and was now able to muscle his way to the middle of the ice and to the net a bit more. "Yeah, it's a little bit of everything. Matt Shaw is unbelievable at what he does. In the gym, it gets us stronger and more prepared. I definitely got stronger throughout the year. It's one of the advantages of playing college hockey," Buium agreed. "You get to not play as many games as the major junior team. Kind of focus more on your workouts. You have more time throughout the day."

The NHL Combine is just around the corner and Buium is ready to shine there as well. "Matt will implement things I'll do at the Combine. Biking, trying to practice the Vo2. Simple things like that. Nothing crazy. A little bit of mobility. Trying to get my ankles better," Buium added.

The interviews at the Combine are paramount. Many believe, and I'm one of them, that they are more important than testing, but the combination is still very important.

"Some could argue that the interviews are as important or more important," Buium emphasized. "With the interviews, they are trying to get to know you as a person and see if you're the kind of person that they want. And their program and for me that's a huge part. For us, we want to get to know them too, and see how we would fit in their locker room and their culture. That's a huge part of why we are at the Combine. I think the testing is great for getting a baseline of where you are at.... Shai (his brother and Denver teammate) has said to enjoy it and take it all in."

College hockey is great for young players because the older players can share their wisdom with the younger players.

"At the NTDP, we're all the same age. We are coming up together. But nobody is really ahead of anybody in that sense. The last two years there were amazing," Buium said. "With college, you are playing with players who are older. More pro-ready. More mature mentally and physically. They teach you different things about yourself and the game.

"For me, it was watching Shai and Sean Behrens play. You learn how to manage the game the right way and really become a winner and play as a winning defenseman."

Lane Hutson is Paving the Way for Cole Hutson

I think both of these players will see NHL time. Can I say for sure they will be everyday players? Not yet, but I'm leaning towards that. Lane Hutson was a riskier pick than Cole. I think the Canadiens and Boston University have done a nice job of developing him. He got two points in his first two games, I know. But better than no points and Lane is so much stronger than he used to be and all the other crazy good offensive traits are there.

I've been lucky enough to see both brothers play quite a bit live and otherwise. Cole is terrific on the power play like Lane. Then there are some differences. Cole can improve his body positioning but he uses his body more than Lane did at this age. His active stick on defense coupled with his crazy edge work makes him dangerous on any shift.

He scored his career 112th point at the U18 Worlds making him the highest-scoring defenseman in the history of the NTDP. I saw a game that Hutson played in the Five Nations that showed off his all-around game. This is something that will be either dismissed or written off by some because he's so good offensively. I am here to tell you that his improvement this year in that area has been impressive.

Odds are against both of the Hutson brothers because of the lack of size as defensemen. I believe the other gifts they have will offset that and these guys will beat the odds someday. We all forget there are changes in the game that always offer up the opportunity for these players to shine. My guess is, that is coming in the next few years.

Cole already weighs more than Lane. He's 170 but Lane is more developed physically. That will happen for Cole as well and that's another reason why I am high on both of these players currently.

Teddy Stiga and Aron Kiviharju Will Rise After the U18 Worlds

Teddy Stiga is a player I saw around six times live this season. Of any player that I thought was underrated on the NTDP, it was him. Now there are a few others who will appear on bigger lists that weren't there, but Stiga is a first-rounder in my eyes and I've felt that way for a long time.

Stiga makes great plays in the corners and behind the net to keep the play going and set up his teammates. He also knows when there's an open lane to score and that's what is, and will be on display at the U18 Worlds. He's a great interview. That will resonate after the 2024 NHL Combine too.

Aron Kiviharju has had an injury-plagued season but is back just in time. He missed four months due to surgery and he's started the U18s strong, reminding scouts about his speed and how much of a weapon he is on the power play. That's a talent that is sought after and is one of the best in the draft. I don't think he's just a power play specialist at the next level either. I think he's better than that. How much? It remains to be seen, but I fully expect him to move up on the next round of rankings in a few weeks.

His covers are mostly fast and clean. I think he might bite too early on some fakes, but I feel that will improve over time. He's 6'4", 210 pounds and most teams are looking for a bigger goalie. I would spend a late-rounder on him and wait for him to fully develop.

He's headed to Harvard, a school with a solid hockey program. "I really loved the conversations I had with the coaches and players there. It really felt like home to me. It's close to home, which I like...It will be nice to come home and play a little bit. My family won't have to travel."

This is the FantasyDrafthelp.com statistic, the Ultimate Quantitative Baseline, based on the statistical principle of standard deviation from the mean. For defensemen and forwards, the relevant statistics are points, goals, assists, penalty minutes and plus-minus. For goalies, the relevant statistics are wins, shutouts, goals against average and save percentage (with the categories being weighted extra since there is one less). In each category, a spectrum is calculated from the best performance to the worst (on a per-game basis for forwards and defensemen).
